- It was part of the most famous temple of Inca times, QoriKancha (Temple of the Sun), declared National Heritage of Cusco.
- Stone of the 8 angles, an archaeological piece that was part of an imperial Inca wall, believed to be connected to the practice of important rituals of the time.

- The suites of the Casona de los Cuatro Bustos, were a Colonial residence during the XVI century.
- 195 colonial art works are on display, 60 of which are original paintings of the Cusco School.
